### I Didn't Know You Had That!

Often we hear, "I didn't know you had that!" when someone learns about a library service. Most people know the Glen Ridge Library is so much more than books, but sometimes even the best library user may not be aware of everything we provide. Here's a list of our services to make sure you're in the know too:

- We are a **member of BCCLS**, a 77 public library consortium in Essex, Bergen, Hudson and Passaic Counties. You can borrow items from any of the libraries in person or request items to be sent here through the online catalog.
- **Productivity services** such as Notary Public, wireless printing, color printing, scanning, copier, fax, public computers and laptops, and fast Wi-Fi. A mini-makerspace houses a 3D printer, button maker, and Cricut Air 2 cutter.
- **Digital collections** such as eBooks and eAudiobooks through OverDrive, digital magazines, digital subscription to the NY Times for all users. Access to Ancestry.com, Lynda.com Learning Library, Rosetta Stone, and research databases on jerseyclicks.org.
- **Programs, events, classes, and clubs for everyone.** From the cookbook club, weekly movies, special events, after school clubs for kids, teen events, storytime classes, to play groups and more, there is always something going on at the library.
- **Local History collection** and archive with a database filled with thousands of digitized photographs, yearbooks, newspapers, and Glen Ridge home information.

**Sign up for Storytime classes and grow with us!**

When children participate in Storytime from a young age, they benefit in so many ways. Children learn vital school readiness skills -- sitting still for a period of time, how to pay attention to an adult other than a parent, taking turns and sharing, and how to be reasonably quiet. Children and caregivers learn songs and rhymes that support their child's learning, while meeting and connecting with others. Our Storytime curriculum focuses on literacy and language development, integrates S.T.E.A.M. activities and concepts, music, body awareness, and confidence in movement. Our library staff are highly skilled in working with young children to help you set the foundation for lifelong learning and a love of reading.

**Little Seeds - Fridays at 9:30 am** We help you plant the seeds for lifelong learning. Designed for children aged 6 - 23 months, the Little Seeds Storytime class consists of books, music, finger plays, rhymes, and movement. Children and caregivers participate in a curriculum that encourages vocabulary, social skills and confidence in movement.

**Note: There is no pre-registration for Little Seeds. Classes are filled on a first come, first served basis each week. The class will close once that day's capacity is filled. A Glen Ridge Library card MUST be shown for entrance to the class.**
